### The Seed Issues

- Indonesia : Tropic with high ecosystem diversity → high biodiversity
  - ex : paddy varieties in Indonesia are more than 200
- Green revolution
   monoculture → super seed; pesticide; fertilizer
   the whole package is promoted by the state to the
   benefit of TNC/MNC
- WTO step in
  - → AOA : diminished all state protection → corporate taking position
  - → TRIP's : Intellectual rights/Patent → seed ≠ grain



- No Patent on life in Indonesia → UU No.29/2000 Plants varieties Protection
  - PT BISI (seed corporation) started to filing sues on farmers into the court
  - The sues were all legally incorrect
- Patent/Intellectual right means
  - farmer marginalization : functionally or economically
  - seed domination
  - food sovereignty lost



### The Water Issues




- Limited water resources, to whom they are allocated?
- WB Water Management policy (1992)
- Water rights concept-shifting common property to private property
- WATSAL Project (1998)-UU SDA No.7/2004
- Economic value will shift water from agriculture to industrial purpose, from rural to urban.


